

## **Deeping Rotary 10K & 3K Fun Run**

### **Terms and Conditions**

#### **1. Event and Agreement**

These terms and conditions apply to the Deeping Rotary Races, consisting of the 10K road race and the 3K Fun Run.

By entering or taking part in the event, participants agree to follow these terms and conditions, together with any instructions issued by the Race Director, race officials, marshals or event organisers.

The event is organised by the **Rotary Club of the Deepings Fundraising Committee** and the 10K race is held under UKA rules and regulations.

#### **2. Entry Fees and Registration**

There will be two entry options:

##### **Online entry:**

Online entries will be available through **Entry Central** until **Wednesday 13th May 2026**, when the system will close.

##### **Race day entry:**

Manual entries may be available on race day only, subject to the maximum entry numbers not being reached.

Online entry fees for the 10K race are:

- £14 for affiliated runners
- £16 for non-affiliated runners

Affiliation means holding a current UKA club membership. This will be automatically verified by the entry system, operated by our booking partners **Entry Central**.

If race day entries are available, the 10K entry fee will be **£20 for all participants**.

Entry for the 3K Fun Run is **£5 for both children and adults**. The Fun Run will remain £5 on race day, with no surcharge applied.

#### **3. Eligibility, Junior Entries and Entry Limits**

Participants in the 10K race must be **15 years or older on race day**.

Children aged **4 to 15** may enter the **3K Fun Run** only. Children aged **4 to 8** must be accompanied by a parent or guardian while taking part.

A **Parental Consent Form for Junior Runners aged 4 to 15 years** must be completed prior to the race.

For any child under 15, the entry must be completed by a parent or guardian. By entering, the parent or guardian confirms that the child is medically able to take part and accepts the normal risks associated with taking part in a running event, including falls, contact with other participants, weather conditions and road or footpath surfaces.

Children taking part remain the responsibility of their parent or guardian at all times.

Entries will be accepted in the order they are received, up to the entry limit of **400 for the 10K race** and **125 for the 3K Fun Run**, or until online entries close, whichever comes first.

In the interest of safety, the Race Director may reduce the entry limit at their discretion.

#### **4. Medical Fitness and Personal Risk**

By entering, each participant confirms that they are medically fit and able to take part in the event.

Participants take part at their own risk and accept the normal risks associated with running, including falls, contact with other participants, weather conditions, road surfaces, traffic, pedestrians and other users of the course.

Participants are responsible for providing accurate entry information, including emergency contact and medical details. The organisers cannot be held responsible for any issue caused by incorrect or incomplete information supplied by the participant.

#### **5. Refunds, Transfers and Conduct**

Once an entry has been accepted, the fee is non-refundable, including if the event is cancelled, postponed, delayed, shortened or altered for safety reasons.

Any withdrawn entry fees will be donated to supported charities.

Entries cannot be transferred to another runner or deferred to the following year.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse or remove any participant displaying inappropriate or offensive behaviour, including clothing or messages that may cause offence.

Failure to follow instructions from race officials, marshals or event organisers may result in disqualification and removal from the event.

#### **6. Safety, Race Conditions and Cancellation**

Race numbers must be clearly displayed on the front of each participant's clothing. The emergency and personal details on the reverse of the race number must be completed before starting.

All 10K entrants must complete the race within **90 minutes**. After this time, anyone still on the course will be treated as a pedestrian and must follow the Highway Code.

Roads remain open to traffic, so all participants must take care and follow marshal instructions at all times.

The organisers reserve the right to alter, delay, shorten, postpone or cancel the event if necessary for safety reasons, including severe weather, medical concerns, road conditions, emergency incidents or instructions from the Police, Highways, UKA officials or other authorities.

If race day temperatures are considered unsafe, the Race Director will consult with the Race Referee and Adjudicator before deciding whether the event should continue. Temperatures of **33°C or above** will result in automatic cancellation on safety grounds.

## **7. Prohibited Items**

For safety reasons, headphones and music-playing devices are not permitted. Wearing any type of headphones may result in disqualification.

Pets, animals, pacesetters and accompanying cyclists are not permitted on the course.

## **8. Prizes and Results**

The Race Referee's decision on prize allocation is final. The Race Director will not enter into discussions regarding prize decisions.

## **9. Personal Information and Media**

By entering the event, participants agree that relevant information may be shared with first aid providers if required.

Personal information may be published as part of the event results and shared with governing bodies or affiliated organisations for insurance, licence and results purposes.

Photographs and videos taken during the event may be used for publicity purposes.

Video recording of the 10K finish will be used solely for result verification and will not be used for any other purpose.
