

1. Event Description and Agreement

- These terms and conditions pertain to The Deeping Rotary Races, including a 10k road race and a 3k fun run.
- By participating in the event, you agree to adhere to these terms and any instructions issued by the race organizers.
- The Deeping Rotary Races adhere to UKA Rules and regulations and are organized by The Deeping Rotary Fundraising Committee.

2. Entry Fees

- There will be two entry systems, (1) Internet online at [Runbritain online race entry](#) until the 16th May 2024 when the system will close. (2) A manual system will be available only on race day with a surcharge of £4.00 / £6.00 for the 10K Race will apply. There will be no surcharge for the Fun Run.
- Entry for the 10k event is £14 for affiliated runners and £16 for non-affiliated runners, where affiliation refers to holding a current UKA Club membership.
- The entry system, operated by our timing partners JC Race Solutions, will automatically verify this requirement.
- Entry for the 3k fun run is £5 for both children and adults.
- Registration for the event is exclusively available through the Runbritain website which closes at 9:00pm 16th May 2024. If we have not reached the maximum entry numbers, "On The Day Entries" will be available for the 10K at £20 for each participant, affiliated or unaffiliated. Fun Run entries will remain available at £5 per participant.

3. Eligibility

- Participants in the 10k race must be 15 years or older on or before May 19, 2024.
- There are no age restrictions for the 3k fun run, although children under 8 must be accompanied by an adult and will only be able to entry by using the "On The Day Entry" System.
- Entries will be accepted in the order they are received, up to the entry limit of 400 for each race, until the closing date of 9 pm on Thursday, May 16, 2024, or until the race limit is reached, whichever comes first.

4. Entry Limit and Safety

- In the interest of safety, the Race Director may, at their discretion, reduce the entry limit.
- Once your entry is accepted, the fee is non-refundable, even if the event is cancelled, and will be donated to supported charities if you withdraw.
- Entries cannot be transferred to another runner or deferred to the following year.

- The organizers reserve the right to refuse participation if deemed inappropriate or offensive behaviour is displayed, including clothing or messages that may cause offense.
- Non-compliance with race officials' instructions will result in disqualification and ejection from the race.

5. Race Number and Time Limit

- Race numbers must be displayed on the front of participants' attire; failure to do so may result in removal from the race.
- On the reverse of the race number, you are required to complete the details requested for your own personal safety.
- All entrants must complete the race within 90 minutes; those still on the course after this time will be considered pedestrians following the highway code.
- Roads are open to traffic, so participants must be cautious and heed marshals' instructions.

6. Prohibited Devices and Items

- The use of headphones and other music-playing devices is not permitted for safety reasons, as they may distract from important instructions. Wearing any type of headphones will result in disqualification.
- Pets, animals, pacemakers, and accompanying cyclists are not allowed during the race.

7. Prize Allocation and Use of Personal Information

- The Race Referee's decisions on prize allocation are final, and the Race Director will not enter into any discussions on this matter.
- By entering the event, you give permission for relevant information provided to be shared with our first aid providers.
- Your Personal Information may be published as part of the event results and shared with governing bodies or affiliated organizations for purposes such as insurance, licenses, and result publication.
- Photographs and videos taken during the race may be used for publicity purposes.
- Video recording of the 10k finish will be solely for result verification and will not be used for other purposes.
